

# CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Entries close on Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> March 2010.
2. **Payment MUST accompany entry form otherwise your entry will not be accepted.**
3. Late Entries will only be considered if payment has been received.
4. **If you fax your entry form without credit card details, your entry will not be accepted.**
5. Once the draw is compiled, no refund will be available except upon production of a medical certificate.
6. CADDIES ARE PERMITTED.
7. Caddies must respect the rights of the competitors at all times. Caddies, whether they be parents or friends are reminded to avoid placing unnecessary pressure on the competitors. No advice should be given to a competitor by a caddy unless requested. Nor should a caddy criticise the decisions or efforts of a competitor at any stage during the event. The organisers of the event reserves the right to withdraw the caddy rights of any person who it believes is not acting in the best interests of the competitor.
8. Competitors will not be permitted to ride on or in any form of automotive locomotion during the play of a hole.
9. Entry implies acceptance of the Conditions of Play governing the Tournament and the organisers reserves the right to alter the Tournament's Conditions of Play without prior notice.
10. Play shall be in accordance with the Rules of Golf and the Local Rules of the host club.
11. **DRESS REGULATIONS** - all competitors and spectators must adhere to the dress regulations of the club. Shirts must have a collar and be worn tucked in, no jeans or denim of any type. Short socks may be worn. Soft spiked golf shoes must be worn. No cargo pants or shorts, mid drift tops or any surf brand clothing.
12. Competitors must deposit all their rubbish in the appropriate receptacles.
13. Sand/Soil buckets must be carried and used if available and returned to the appropriate place at the conclusion of play.
14. All divots and pitch marks must be repaired irrespective of the availability of sand/soil buckets.
15. Competitors **MUST NOT** use unacceptable language before, during or after play nor throw or mistreat their own or fellow competitors equipment.
16. Smoking by competitors is prohibited at all times.
17. **Use of mobile telephones on the course by competitor or caddie is prohibited. Penalty – Disqualification**
18. **In the event of a tie for the overall championship, (both boys and girls) a sudden death play off starting from the 10<sup>th</sup> tee will be held.**
