ON COURSE DRESS REGULATIONS

FOR ALL MEMBERS, GUESTS AND CASUAL PATRONS

The minimum required dress standard is clean, neat and tidy at all times.

ACCEPTABLE DRESS INCLUDES:

Tailored slacks, knee or 3/4 length tailored or cargo style shorts with a belt or braces. Collared shirts or polo with turtle or crew neck. Note: Waist length shirts may be worn outside slacks or shorts providing they have been tailored to do so.

Long socks, pulled up at all times OR short plain predominantly white socks or ankle type socks with or without a logo. (Ankle must be covered)

Fully enclosed soft or steel spiked golf shoes or flat soled sports shoes. All clothing worn on the Course must be appropriate for golf.

NOT ACCEPTABLE DRESS INCLUDES:

Elastic or drawstring shorts/trousers. Denim, tracksuits, board shorts or sports shorts. No low slung pants/shorts are to be worn. Hawaiian style shirts or t-shirts. Shirts with extensive advertising or offensive motifs. Football wear (jumpers, shorts or socks)

CLUB HOUSE DRESS REGULATIONS

FOR ALL MEMBERS, GUESTS AND CASUAL PATRONS

The minimum required dress standard is clean, neat and tidy at all times.

ACCEPTABLE DRESS INCLUDES:

Dress as worn on course acceptable. Enclosed shoes or boat shoes may be worn without socks. Leather sandals with a full heel strap.

NOT ACCEPTABLE DRESS INCLUDES:

Board shorts, sports shorts, drawstring or elastic waist shorts or trousers. Steel spiked shoes. Shirts with extensive advertising or offensive motifs. Any style of thongs/masseurs/ugg boots or scuffs. Casual beachwear, hats, caps or hoods.

Football wear (jumpers, shorts or socks)

The Club Management and the Board of Directors reserve the right to refuse admission to anyone not considered suitably attired.
